## Special Naturalization Ceremony in Fort Scott, Kansas

The United States District Court for the District of Kansas will host a special naturalization ceremony at the Fort Scott National Historic Site in Fort Scott, Kansas, on Friday, September 20, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. The Honorable Teresa J. James, United States Magistrate Judge for the District of Kansas, will officiate the event on the historic grounds.

Musical performances will be provided by the Fort Scott High School Orchestra.
